MUSICFEST INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL

Musicfest International Summer School runs alongside the Festival Programme, and provides an opportunity for musicians from all over the world to join together to learn and play music together. Open to music students, professionals, teachers, and adult amateurs, courses are available for instrumentalists (with an emphasis on chamber music), choral singing, percussion and composition, plus this year, for the first time, saxophone and trombone. There are opportunities for solo masterclasses & workshops, and concerts where artists and participants play together. In recent years students have included musicians from all over Europe, Israel, Singapore, Japan, Australia, and the USA.

Many of the team of artists are regular visitors to Musicfest, and have made recordings of

repertoire performed at the festival for IMP Classics, which have been released to great critical acclaim. Highlights of the courses for 1997 include two new courses for trombone and saxophone, and following last year's huge success, two percussion courses with the amazing Ensemble Bash, catering for both experienced players and novices with an emphasis on World Music.

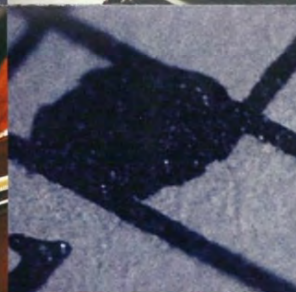

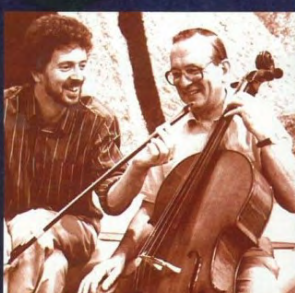
